The Jeff Moyer Show - We're People First - and Set of the Sails YouTube Network announce ASL Sign Language Show Interpretation

Chula Vista, CA - The groundbreaking Jeff Moyer Show announces the inclusion of American Sign Language (ASL) in all shows beginning with the 05/27/2021 Show. The Jeff Moyer Show is a wholly unique YouTube bi-weekly show which is opening viewers' minds and hearts to all members of the human family, what Jeff calls "people first consciousness".

Disability Grand Master, Jeff Moyer, brings a half century of personal history as a leader in the disability and social change movement, membership in the National Hall of Fame for People with Disabilities, 600 original songs, Phase II Certification by the Department of Justice as a Member of the ADA Implementation Network, 6 books, 200 indigenous and folk instruments, and a wry wit to this program. Jeff's wife, Cristi Moyer, the bon vivant special educator with half a century of instructing infants through graduate students, and roles as a leader in the Californian Teachers Union and worked as a teacher peer coach, co-hosts the Show.

"We searched high and low for the right interpreter for our show. Keara is the answer to our search," said Cristi Moyer, Associate Producer and Co-Host. "Keara's artistic interpretation enriches all of our show's songs and every spoken idea. ASL is an important and regular feature of the Show."

The couple strives for total inclusion in the show's broadcast elements and content. The ASL and Nationally Certified Artistic Interpreter, Keara Beck, is given a half screen (a third when guest-speakers are present) as a regular component of every show, making her engaging signing readable on small screen devices. This innovation is an "Open for Business" sign and "Welcome" mat for everyone using ASL.

"Since the show is about the human condition including all aspects of disability, it would have particular meaning to many people with hearing disabilities. We believe that ASL is an important part of how we are broadcasting", said Moyer. "We are committed to access for all."

ASL Interpretation is provided by Keara Beck Ortt of Nicholasville, Kentucky. "Keara specializes in Artistic Interpreting and works in a variety of settings including theatrical, educational, post secondary and medical. Keara has a Bachelor's of Science in Interpreting from Eastern Kentucky University and a Bachelor's of Arts in Media Communications from Asbury University".
